TEST SITE DESCRIPTION: Lions Park East is nestled in the historic Old Golden downtown area at the base of Lookout Mountain. Golden, while maintaining its independent city status, remains a suburb of Denver to the west of downtown. It is easily reached from the north and south via Interstate Highway I-70 and Colorado Highway 58. The draft test utilizes almost the entire park. There is a small lake on the grounds. The maneuvering course is a tree filled area with picnic tables and playgrounds nearby mostly grass with some dirt area around some of the trees. Immediate test site will utilize a covered pavilion in the east corner of the park as its staging area. There is plenty of shade and covered area for entrants, dog crates and spectators. There is a flat, grassy area for obedience. The freight haul portion will begin among the trees and picnic tables and will then utilize the walking trail along Clear Creek. There will be some slight hills along the creek path with the course going over a wooden pedestrian bridge and then crossing a steel bridge.

DIRECTIONS: From the north or east, take I-70 west to Highway 58. Take HWY 58 West to the Washington Ave exit. Turn left onto Washington this brings you into Golden. Go right on 10th Ave, this street dead ends at Lions Park. From the South: Take C-470 to 6th Ave West. Follow 6th Ave West to HWY 58. Turn Right (Eastbound) on HWY 58. Take the Washington Ave exit and turn right. Turn right on 10th Ave. This street dead-ends at Lions Park.

REGULATIONS: The draft test is sanctioned by the Working Dog Committee of the Newfoundland Club of America (NCA) and sponsored by the High Country Newfoundland Club (HCNC). Entrants are responsible for obtaining and reading the regulations governing NCA Draft Tests. Copies of the regulations may be found on line at www.newfdogclub.org or by contacting the Working Dog Committee Publications Secretary, Dwight Gorsuch, 6282 Burriss Road, Rock Hall, MD 2166. This test will be held under the NCA Draft Test Regulations revised October 30, 1999

ENTRIES: The entry fee for the Newfoundland Test, team and re-qualification is \$40.00. Send entry fees (payable to HCNC), a completed entry form and a copy of your dog's registration to: Carol Perkowski, Test Secretary, 9560 Castle Ridge Circle, Highlands Ranch, CO 80129. **All entries that provide an email address will be notified by email of their entry receipt. After the closing date, entry confirmations will be sent by USPS.**

ENTRY LIMITATIONS: Entries for the draft tests are limited to a total of 15. All entries will be accepted beginning with postmarks on March 1, 2010. **Entries close at 6:00 p.m. on April 16, 2010** or when the entry is filled, an alternate list will be established. In order to provide equal opportunity for all exhibitors, entries will be accepted in order of postmark date. In the event of a postmark date tie, a random drawing will be made. No fax, email or phone entries will be accepted.

RE-QUALIFIERS: Re-qualifiers will be accepted on a space available basis. Untitled dogs will be given first priority even if their entry is postmarked after that of a titled dog. Entries will close when 15 untitled entries for the single and team divisions are received prior to or on the closing date, whichever occurs first. If entries fill, an alternate list will be established. Openings will be filled from the alternate list in postmark order. In the event of a postmark tie, a random drawing will be made.

MISCELLANEOUS: Bitches in season will be allowed to participate. However, bitches will be judged after ALL other entries have completed the test. Unentered dogs must be kept quiet, on leash, or crated, and away from the designated test area.

HCNC SPECIALTY CARTING ENTRY FORM

The Specialty Cart and Wagon Exercises have been developed to meet a demand for standardized exercises to be used at Specialty shows. Because Specialty shows generally have facilities only for carts and wagons, other draft apparatus have largely been ignored for these exercises. The exercises have also been designed largely for people interested in exhibition cart and wagon activities. Therefore the exercises have been chosen to test the abilities of dog and handler to meet the tasks required for activities such as parade carting. Even so, these regulations also attempt to stress a working relationship between dog and handler. Judging is on a pass/fail basis because every-day cart and wagon activities are diverse; no standard short set of exercises can adequately test all draft abilities of all dogs entered. *Specialty carting rules can be found on the NCA website under Working Dogs.
