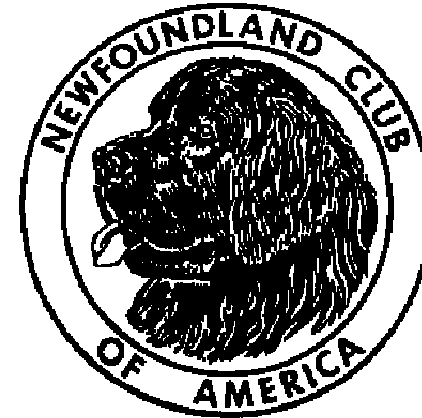

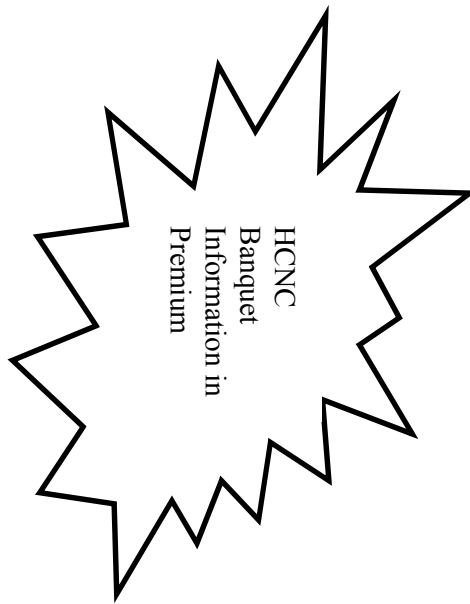

AKC Grand Champion Select Competition (effective May 12, 2010)

The Grand Champion Select Competition Class shall be for dogs that are Champions of Record competing in Best of Breed. This includes dogs transferred to Best of Breed which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed. In addition, Champions that win Non-Regular Classes & become eligible for Best of Breed competition (altered or spayed Champion Veteran Class winners at independent specialties) are eligible. Winners Dog & Winners Bitch are not eligible for Grand Champion competition. At the judge's discretion, Grand Championship points may be awarded to Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Select Dog or Select Bitch. Grand Champion Competition will not continue beyond Best of Breed Competition.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES – INVOLVING SINGLE DOG ENTRIES

Working Dog: A class for dogs who have earned a NCA Working Title.

Working Bitch: A class for bitches who have earned a NCA Working Title.

Veteran Dog Class: A class for Dogs seven (7) years or older

Veteran Bitch Class: A class for Bitches seven (7) years or older.

Note: Chapter 11, Section 8 of the Dog Show Rules provides that castrated males may be entered in the Veteran Dog Class and spayed females may be entered in the Veteran Bitch Class at independent Specialties.

Non-Regular (Additional) Classes Involving Multiple Dog Entries

Stud Dog Class: For Stud Dogs and two and not more than 4 of their Get. Get must be entered in another class at this show. It is not necessary for the Get to be under the same ownership as the Stud Dog. Stud Dog must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and shown in the ring with his Get. The merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry. The class will be judged on the merits of the Get. Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification under AKC Dog Show Rules. The Stud Dog shall be considered one entry and requires one entry fee, this being the regular fee plus the additional fee if the Stud Dog is entered in another class.

Brood Bitch Class: Same as Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

Note: Chapter 11, Section 8 of the AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows provides that castrated males and spayed bitches are allowed to be entered in Stud Dog or Brood Bitch.

Brace Class: A brace is defined as two dogs of the same recognized breed or variety that are similar in appearance, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in brace competition must have at least one common owner. Dogs comprising a Brace must be named at the time of entry. **BOTH DOGS MUST BE ENTERED IN ANOTHER CLASS.**

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

NOVICE JUNIOR CLASS: For Boys & Girls at least 9 and under 12 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three first-place awards with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS: For Boys & Girls at least 12 and under 15 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three first-place awards with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE SENIOR CLASS: For Boys & Girls at least 15 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three first-place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present.

OPEN JUNIOR CLASS: For Boys & Girls at least 9 and under 12 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three first-place awards in a Novice Junior Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present.

OPEN INTERMEDIATE: For Boys & Girls at least 12 and under 15 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three first-place awards in a Novice Junior Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present.

OPEN SENIOR CLASS: For Boys & Girls at least 15 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three first-place awards in a Novice Junior Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present.

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC Junior Handler NUMBER on each entry.

BE SURE INFORMATION for Junior Showmanship classes is entered on front and back of entry form.

OBEDIENCE TRIAL in the 4-H building

A qualifying score is required for all prizes in the regular classes.

A dark green qualifying ribbon will be given to each dog attaining a qualifying score in a regular class.

NOTE: A refund of entry fees for bitches entered in obedience that come in season after entries close may be obtained by presenting a veterinarian certificate to the show secretary prior to the start of the show. Move-Ups will be allowed at this obedience trial.

Dogs shown in Sweepstakes must also be entered in a regular class at the regular entry fee. Indicate Sweepstakes Class with the age division under "Additional Classes." Sweepstakes will be judged prior to the regular classes. Champions of Record may enter Sweepstakes Competition.

Neutered dogs and spayed bitches may be entered in Veteran Sweepstakes.

Veteran, 7 yrs & under 9 yrs ♦ Veteran, 9 yrs and older

Division of Entry Money as Prizes:

35% will be retained by the Club for expenses. The remaining 65% will be divided as follows:

Exhibitors will be subject to disciplinary action by the Show Committee for any reported damages. The American Kennel Club will be notified of any destruction/soiling of Hotel grounds or property. You are REQUIRED to clean up area after walking your dogs on a leash at any hotel/motel. DO NOT leave dogs unattended inside any motel room. Please crate your dogs while they are in the room. DO NOT groom your dog inside rooms.

CITY OF GREELEY ORDINANCE – DOGS ARE NOT ALLOWED IN ANY CITY PARK EXCEPT ISLAND GROVE PARK.

EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

"A recording fee of 50 cents and a \$3.00 AKC Event fee per entry will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show or Obedience Trial. A \$3.00 Event Fee will be required for each entry of each dog in the Rally Trial. This recording fee is to be collected by the show giving club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class at the show, the recording fee is to be collected on the first entry only" Ch. 11, Section 2, AKC Dog Show Rules.

ALL EXHIBITORS MUST SUBMIT FEES IN US FUNDS. No Cash.

No entry may be sent by any method that requires a signature for delivery.

Entry fee will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a Veterinarian or Judge or barred from competition by action of a Show Committee.

Post dated checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The ABTC will add a collection fee of \$25.00 to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in them being put on a CASH ONLY basis. No entry fees will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strike and/or any other cause beyond the control of the NCA or Show Secretary.

Due to the costs of processing, refunds of \$3.00 or less will not be made.

No entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Entries will not be accepted without fees or signatures. There are no refunds for duplicate entries. The Show Secretary will make every effort to find duplicate entries, but if an entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

This club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form.

Changes, additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to the close of entries. The owner or agent assumes all responsibilities for wrong or incomplete information in the entry blanks.

Entries must be made on an Official AKC Entry Form, or photocopy of the Official AKC Entry Form with the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side, or they cannot be accepted. Owners are responsible for errors in completing entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellations after the published closing date.

Agents may indicate their name on entry forms for inclusion in the catalog, provided they are 18 years old and neither own nor co-own the dog.

The show giving Club, the Show Secretary, their agents, employees, etc. assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assumes no responsibility to children.

Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging, and will be released if not needed for further judging. Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the Club, nor the Show Secretary will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.

The Club reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value. All prizes must be claimed the day of the show, none will be mailed.

The Show Site will be available to exhibitors from 8:00 am to 10:00 pm, Thursday, August 19, 2010. The site will again be available at 6:00 am on Friday, August 20, 2010; Saturday August 21, 2010, & Sunday August 22, 2010. Dogs must be removed from the show site immediately following Best in Show judging on Sunday August 22, 2010.

The grounds at this show include the show buildings, outside show grounds, and all parking areas.

There shall be no drilling or intensive or abusive training of dogs on the show grounds.

A dog wash area is available outside the Exhibition on the west end.

All regulations governing the use of this facility, and all regulations and decisions of the Show Committee of this show giving club on this day will be strictly enforced, including those in the Premium List, but not limited by them.

Grooming area is set up under the supervision of the Building Grounds Committee, who may require rearrangement of exhibitor's set-ups where space is not utilized. Crating space is available on a first come basis. No additional crating space inside the building may be saved by roping off, or using empty crates, chairs or other equipment to hold space.

All dogs present must be held on a leash or confined to their crates or exercise pens, except when being judged.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendations to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites and have appropriate vaccinations.

Crates must be stacked when ever possible in all grooming areas.

Reserved grooming space is available in the air conditioned Exhibition Building, free grooming is available in the Livestock Building. Exercise Pens may be set up in the Livestock Building. Information for reserved grooming is in the GKC show premium available at WWW.ONOFRIO.COM.

Exhibitors and handlers will be held responsible for clean conditions at, and around their set-up area.

Dogs may be exercised ONLY in designated areas outside the building.

NO CRATING OR GROOMING IN THE OUTDOOR PICNIC PAVILION.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their own dogs AT ALL TIMES. Each exhibitor is responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Pooper-Scoopers will be placed around the show grounds. If your dog soils in the show ring, the stewards will hold your dog while you do the clean-up.

Crates may be set up in chalked areas only during breed judging and must be removed when judging for that breed is over. No setups will be allowed in the building.

NO dogs will be allowed in the restrooms. Dumping of dog food or grooming residue into the restroom sinks and toilets is strictly prohibited.

NO unentered dogs will be allowed on the show grounds during show hours.

No generators to operate within 100 feet of any ring during judging times.

Do not leave dogs in closed vehicles. Dogs must not be tied to bushes, shrubs, trees or other permanent fixtures.

Parents are solely responsible for their children, and are expected to keep them supervised and controlled at all times for their own safety. No baby strollers in the show buildings.

PARKING REGULATIONS

GKC reserves the right to remove any animal in distress from a parked vehicle or crate any way necessary. GKC solely determines if said animal is in distress. All persons attending this dog show hereby waive any claim for damages against the club for such removal.

No vehicles will be allowed to enter the park between 10:00 PM and 6:00 AM. No dogs outside vehicles between 11:00 PM and 6:00 AM.
